


STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. We believe in the Scripture of the Old and New Testament, in their original writing, as fully inspired of God and accept them as the supreme and final authority for church activities, church operation, faith and life.
2. We believe in one God, eternally existing and manifesting Himself in three Person- Father, Son and Holy Spirit
3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Father, conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary and is the true God and true Man
4. We believe that God created man in his own image.
5. That man sinned and thereby incurred the penalty of sin which is death physically and spiritual
6. That all human being inherit a sinful nature.
7. With regards to sexual behavior, we believe in heterosexual between a natural man and natural woman within the confines of lawful matrimony.
8. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins a substitution sacrifice according to the scripture and that all who believe in Him are justified on the grounds of His shed blood.
9. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, His ascension into Heaven, and His present life as our High Priest and Advocate.
10. We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.
11. We believe in baptism of water and that is symbolic of dying and rising with Jesus Christ and it has a spiritual significant and importance in the lives of believers.
12. We believe that all who repent of their sin and receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.
13. With regard to submission to authority, we believe in the principle of being in authority because you are under authority. As such, it is understood that membership shall be subject to submission to authority in matters pertaining to church governance, doctrine and personal behavior.
14. We believe in the baptism in the Holy Spirit, empowering and equipping believers for service, with the accompanying supernatural gift of the Holy Spirit; and in fellowship with the Holy Spirit. We believe in the divinely ordained ministries of Apostle, Profits, Evangelist, Pastor and Teacher.

15. We believe in the resurrection of both the just and the unjust, the eternal blessedness of the redeemed, and the eternal punishment of those who have rejected the offer of salvation
 16. We believe that the one true church is the one that lives by every word that comes from the mouth of God and it is redeemed by Jesus Christ and regenerated by the Holy Spirit, that the new birth and personal confession of Jesus Christ are essential for church membership
 17. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ appointed two ordinances –baptism in water and the Lord's Supper to be observed as acts of obedience and as perpetual witness to the cardinal facts of the Christian faith' that baptism is the immersion of the believer in water as a confession of identification with Christ in burial and resurrection and that the Lord's Supper is the partaking of the meal including bread and wine symbolic to the Saviour's broken body and shed blood, in remembrance of His sacrificial death until he comes
 18. We believe that divine healing was provided for in the Old and New Testament and is an integral part of the gospel
 19. We believe that the bible teaches that without holiness no man can see the Lord. We believe in the doctrine of sanctification as a definite, yet progressive work of grace commencing at the time of new birth and continuing until the consummation of salvation
 20. The church is open to any further truth which the holy spirit may illuminate from the scriptures
